WHO WE ARE

The Fairfax County Fire and Rescue Department is a premier all-hazards fire and rescue department committed to providing emergency and non-emergency services to protect the lives, property, and environment of our community.

We provide basic life support (BLS) and advanced life support (ALS) emergency medical, fire suppression, technical rescue, hazardous materials response, water rescue, life safety education, fire prevention, and arson investigation services.

We have 1,400 uniformed personnel, 39 fire and rescue stations, and a large apparatus fleet.



ALS INTERNSHIP *CONTINUING EDUCATION*

- Immersive (6) month FTEP model internship broken into (4) phases
- Weekly workshops with hands-on case-based learning
- Continuing education credits earned while on duty
- State of the art training equipment, instructors, and active Medical Director participation

SHIFT *SCHEDULE*

24-Hour shift schedule with three rotating shifts (A, B, and C)

- 24 Hours On (7 a.m. to 7a.m.)
- 24 Hours Off
- 24 Hours On (7 a.m. to 7 a.m.)
- 24 Hours Off
- 24 Hours On (7 a.m. to 7 a.m.)
- 4 Days Off

MINIMUM *QUALIFICATIONS:*

- Age 18 or Older
- High School Diploma or GED
- Valid Driver's License
- Drug free last 12 Months
- No More than Two Moving Violations in the Last 12 Months
- **NREMT-P or VA EMT-P Certification**



RIDING *ASSIGNMENTS*

ALS providers ride a variety of apparatus and are assigned to many roles such as, driver, firefighter, lead provider, or officer. ALS riding pay is also compensated at \$2 an hour while on a fire suppression unit and \$3 an hour while on a transport unit.
